Privacy policy - General information

The data collected when visiting this website is processed by Catalytica Consulting Sàrl in its capacity as provider of this website. You can find more information about Sàrl in the "Home" section.

Based on Article 13 of the Swiss Federal Constitution and the data protection provisions of the Swiss Confederation (Data Protection Act, DSG), every person has the right to protection of his or her privacy and to protection against misuse of his or her personal data. The protection of your personal data and privacy is of particular concern to Catalytica Consulting Sàrl. For this reason, Catalytica Consulting Sàrl treats your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the legal data protection regulations and this privacy policy.

In cooperation with the hosting provider, Catalytica Consulting Sàrl makes every effort to protect the databases as well as possible against unauthorized access, loss, misuse or forgery. Nevertheless, Catalytica Consulting Sàrl points out that data transmission on the Internet (e.g., when communicating by e-mail or contact form) can have security gaps. Accordingly, complete protection of data against access by third parties is not possible.

Personal data

This website can generally be visited without registering and disclosing your personal data. However, if you visit the website of Catalytica Consulting Sàrl, certain data, such as IP addresses and other usage information, will be automatically collected by our web analysis software and evaluated and processed anonymously in accordance with generally accepted practice. Personal data, in particular name, address or e-mail address, is collected as far as possible on a voluntary basis and Catalytica Consulting Sàrl only receives it from you if you use certain services or if you contact Catalytica Consulting Sàrl directly. No data will be passed on to third parties without your consent. Cookies

This website uses cookies. These are small text files that make it possible to store specific, userrelated information on the user's terminal device while the user is using the website. Cookies make it possible, in particular, to determine the frequency of use and the number of users of the pages, to analyze the behavior of page use, but also to make the offer more customer-friendly and to continuously improve the website. SSL / TLS encryption

This website uses SSL/TLS encryption for security reasons and to protect the transmission of confidential content, such as the inquiries you send to us as the issuer. Automatic protocols

The provider of this website automatically logs every call in a temporary log file - this data is automatically transmitted to us by your browser. This data is not merged with other data sources. Contractual services

Catalytica Consulting Sàrl processes the data of its contractual partners and interested parties as well as other clients, customers, customers or contractual partners (uniformly referred to as "contractual partners") in accordance with the data protection provisions of the Swiss Federal Data Protection Act (Datenschutzgesetz, DSG) and the EU Data Protection Regulation (EU-DSGVO) pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b. DSGVO. DSGVO, in order to provide them with our contractual or pre-contractual services. The data processed in this context, the type, scope and purpose and the necessity of their processing are determined by the underlying contractual relationship.
